Our 5<sup>th</sup> grades have chosen the local Toys for Tots Organization for our December Spirit Day recipient. Toys for Tots is a Marine Corps organization that has been helping put a little hope and cheer in children's hearts and a glimmer in their eye on Christmas mornings. This is done by charitable contributions of the great community we are honored to call home. All funds and donations raised in our communities are kept and distributed 100 percent back into our community. Toys for Tots is completely run by volunteers with no locally paid staff. Of the dollars raised, 92.8 percent is used to buy toys for children. The difference is the cost of office supplies, tickets for pancake breakfast tickets, etc. and the organization is working toward asking for office supply donations to bring the number up to 98 percent towards gifts for children. Toys for Tots is very thankful for all of the donations given to them and welcome volunteers to help sort and/or deliver toys, assist in the local warehouse, work with families, and help with fundraisers.
