Dear St. Peter Parents and Students,

I would like to take this time to share with you that there is an addendum to our St. Peter School Parent/Student Handbook.

With the ever changing technology it is difficult to determine the type of electronics permitted at school. In addition to such things as Gameboys, iPods, non school issued iPads, MP3 players, tablets, Kindles, Nooks, and e-Readers we are adding Apple watches, Android Watches and/or smart watches to the list of items that are not to be brought to school. If a student chooses to bring any of the above to school the device will be taken and kept in the office for the parent/guardian to pick up. After the third offense, the device will be kept until the close of the school year.

At this time, Fitbits (and or similar fitness devices) are permitted in the event that they do not cause a distraction during the school day. If advanced technology changes on such devices they may be added to the list of items to be kept at home.

***ELECTRONIC TOYS/DEVICES***

All electronic toys/devices such as Gameboys, iPods, MP3 players, iPads, tablets, Kindles, Nooks, e-Readers, **Smart watches (Apple watches, Android watches – smart watches)** etc. are not to be brought to school or on the school premises. (This includes any time that you are on the premises, before and after school.) If a student chooses to bring any of the above to school, the device will be taken and kept in the office for the parent/guardian to pick up. After the third offense, the device will be kept until the close of the school year.

Grades that bring items for show and tell must follow the teacher/classroom rules regarding acceptable items.
