Doctor exams must be on the IDPH form. We have extra forms in the office if you need one. Please remember that there is a parent section that must be completed and signed by a parent.

Please note these exams are mandated by the State of Illinois. These exams must be on file with the school by October 15, 2018 or we are required to exclude your child from school until the exam has been performed and the form is turned into the school office.

Thank you for your help with this matter. We also wish to thank, Mrs. Ann Anderson, our volunteer school nurse, for all the hours she devotes to our school to make sure we are in compliance with the State of Illinois health regulations.
