QCES CURRICULUM MAPPING

During October and November, the QCES teachers began working together on creating a common Science curriculum. The teachers from Blessed Sacrament, St. Francis, St. Dominic, and St. Peter participated in half day meetings with their grade level colleagues. The teachers from each school shared what is currently being taught and discussed the Next Generation Science Standards. At the conclusion of each session, the grade level teams collaboratively agreed on what science units all four schools will teach. Through this work, the teachers were not only able to create horizontal alignment for the four schools at each grade but also develop collaborative relationships.

Although we don't want to accept it, it appears cold weather is officially here and with that brings children wearing sweatshirts, sweaters, coats, hats and gloves. Since our Lost and Found is growing day by day, please help us out with this by taking a few minutes to mark your child's name in these items. This makes it so much easier for teachers and staff to locate any lost items and return to your children. Even in our classrooms we have students become warm and take off their sweatshirt or sweater but then don't remember when their teacher asks students to claim it. We have the same situation in the lunch room. Students hang their coats, hats, and gloves on hooks as they enter the cafeteria. When it is time to go out for recess, they can't wait to get outside and don't remember their coats. We remind them of this but we always have coats, hats, or gloves on the floor after the students are outside. If their names were in it, we could easily return the item to your child. Thank you for helping us out with this. It truly can be a win-win situation.

COLD WEATHER AND RECESS

One more item about the cold weather...Please make sure your child comes to school dressed to go outside at recess. The majority of our students want to go outside and the energy release helps them during their school day. With this in mind, we plan to go outside for recess each day. We may be outside for the entire recess of 15-20 minutes or depending on the weather, we could shorten the time to 10 minutes. We are, however, going outside each day unless the weather is too severe. We have noticed several children coming to school in just hoodies or jackets, and some still wearing shorts. Please make sure that your children are dressed appropriately for the colder temperatures. Please, also, have them wear winter coats, hats, and gloves - with their names or initials marked inside each item. Thank you for your help with this matter.
