GINGERBREAD HOUSES

Did you know that we have a tradition at St. Peter School? For the last 32 years our Kindergarten students have constructed a gingerbread house with their parents or chosen loved one. Many of our St. Peter School alumni still talk about the time that they made their own gingerbread houses when they were in Kindergarten. In fact, some have reported that they still have their creation and they bring it out every year as they decorate for Christmas!

CLASSROOM ADVENT ACTIVITIES

Within this season of Advent, our students have been busy sharing their concern and generosity with others in our community. During this special time of year our focus has been on serving others as well as learning about the true reason for the Christmas season.

Our preschool students had a birthday party for Jesus and they used an Advent calendar to count down the days. Each day they received a sweet surprise. Additionally, they recognized each week of Advent by adding the light to their candle on a wreath that hung on their door.

Grades K-3 held a Baby Shower for Jesus. We were able to deliver many items to Quincy Care Net. We also presented Care Net with our Spirit Day donations from September and October. This school year's first quarter donations were designated for Care Net.

The third grade students also wrote Christmas cards to the shut-ins. They opened an Advent calendar each day and completed random acts of kindness from the messages they received. Additionally, they learned about the Jesse Tree. Each student was responsible for a particular person in Jesus' family and shared information about that person. An ornament was also created that symbolized the family member.

Our fourth grade students purchased a high chair and toys from the Giving Wreath and sent Christmas cards to the shut-ins from our Parish.

The fifth grade students completed 3 service projects for Advent: taking a field trip to Horizon's Soup Kitchen to help paint bowls for their annual fundraiser, collecting money to purchase a gift from the Advent wreath from the Church and they wrote Christmas letters to our parishioner shut-ins.

Sixth grade classes completed an Advent calendar of kind deeds for people in our school, in their class, and in our community.

Seventh and eighth grade students took part in a service project for Chaddock Foster Services. Chaddock has set up a community room where parents can do crafts and play games with their children. This is where families would spend supervised time together. We supported our local community (our neighbor) through craft supplies and small games such as decks of cards, or card games. They also requested any holiday decorations including outside lights. Our goal was to make their holiday a little brighter. We will deliver these items before Christmas.

Hopefully, through your children's efforts, generosity, and prayers, others in the community will feel the outpouring of God's love this Christmas season.
