PARENT NIGHT/DRESS REHEARSAL - FEBRUARY 28th

Parent Night/Dress Rehearsal is Thursday, February 28th, at 6:30 pm in our school gym. All K-6th students and 7th/8th students in the Grandparents Day Electives Class are expected to participate. This is part of their Music Curriculum/grade and has been on our school calendar from the beginning of the school year. Students should be in their classrooms between 6:00-6:15 except for our 7th/8th grade students. Instead of going to their classrooms in Seton Hall, our 7th and 8th grade students will meet in Mrs. Reeder's Music Classroom.

If that is not possible, then students, upon arrival should leave their coats in their youngest brother or sister's classroom and then report to their own classroom.
