WORLD AUTISM AWARENESS DAY - APRIL 2nd

Autism, or autism spectrum disorder (ASD), refers to a broad range of conditions characterized by challenges with social skills, repetitive behaviors, speech and nonverbal communication. According to the Centers for Disease Control, autism affects an estimated 1 in 59 children in the United States today. Indicators of autism usually appear by age 2 or 3. Some associated development delays can appear even earlier, and often, it can be diagnosed as early as 18 months. Research shows that early intervention leads to positive outcomes later in life for people with autism.

Since Autism affects so many children and to help bring awareness of this, we are participating in the World Autism Awareness Day on April 2^{nd} . Students and staff may wear light blue or blue shirts with out of dress code bottoms. Please keep all children with autism in your prayers. We pray that research continues and answers continue to be found.
