SCHOOL HEALTH FORMS - FORMS MUST BE ON FILE WITH OUR SCHOOL BY OCT 15th

Just a reminder to our current Preschool, Kindergarten, 6th grade, and new students - we must have on file the Illinois State mandated IDPH Health exam form. These doctor exams must have been done within the past 14 months (after August 16, 2018). We are still missing several student's current exam forms. These forms are required to be on file with the school by October 15, 2019 or your child will be excluded from school until the exam has been performed and the form is turned into the school office. Please make every effort to have your child's information turned in as we do not want to ever exclude any child from attending school.

Preschool - If your child is attending Preschool for the first time at St. Peter School, either 3 or 4 year old PK, we are required to have this health exam on file.

Kindergarten-Kindergarten students are required to have the health exam and a separate eye examination performed; both forms must be on file with the school. These are both due by October 15th.

Sixth Grade - All incoming 6^{th} grade students are required to have this health exam completed within the August 16, 2018 requirement.

New Students grades 1-8 - if your child is new to St. Peter School this year, we should receive his/her health form from their previous school. New students that have moved to Illinois from another state must have a physical on the IDPH form from within the year's timeline. If your child is in 6^{th} grade and new to our school this year he/she is required to have had a health exam within the past 14 months. We will need this paperwork by the Oct. 15^{th} deadline.

Thank you again to the many parents that have turned these required documents in to us. We will send out a second reminder this coming week to parents that we are still missing this information from. If you need an examination form, please contact the school office.
