### SCHOOL HEALTH FORMS - FORMS MUST BE ON FILE WITH OUR SCHOOL BY OCT 15th

All Preschool, Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students, and new students to Illinois Schools must have had a physical exam within the past school year (since Oct. 16, 2018). Kindergarten and new students to Illinois must also have a vision exam. These IDPH Forms must be to the school office by Tuesday, October 15<sup>th</sup>. Students that are missing this information have been notified through a letter home to parents. We will send another notice home this week. Students that do not have this requirement turned into school on October 15<sup>th</sup> must be excluded from school according to State of Illinois mandates until the proper paperwork is turned in. <u>Please make every effort to have your child's information turned in as we do not want to ever exclude any child from attending school.</u>
