STUDENTS AND SIBLINGS WITH SUSPECTED COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

We have had some questions concerning children that are not feeling well and their siblings attending school. Our current guidelines from the IDPH state the following:

If a student is sent home sick with suspected COVID 19 symptoms (cough, fever, diarrhea, shortness of breath, vomiting, etc.) must all their siblings/household members be sent home as well and quarantined for 14 calendar days?

Yes, if one of the household members is being evaluated for COVID 19, the rest of the household must be quarantined until an alternative diagnosis is made or a negative result is received. Medical evaluation and COVID 19 diagnostic testing are strongly recommended for all persons with COVID-like symptoms. If the sick student becomes a confirmed case (tests positive for COVID) or a probable case (has symptoms and is linked to a known case), the Adams County Health Dept. will conduct contact tracing and will place household contacts, including siblings, in quarantine for 14 calendar days. The Health Dept. will also provide guidance on how to safely quarantine and isolate within the household. If your child's doctor determines that he/she does not have COVID, please have them email/fax our school office a signed letter confirming his/her diagnosis with the date that they may return to school. Healthy siblings may then return to school.

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN SESSIONS

During the current state of Covid-19, Protecting God's Children can be completed **ONLINE** or in person. This is a ONE TIME certification. Who needs to participate? Anyone age 18 years or older who volunteers or is involved in a ministry. This includes Ushers, Lectors, Greeters, Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion, PSR teachers and volunteers and any St. Peter school parent that volunteers in the classroom,

library, cafeteria, or drives for a field trip and other various ministries.
