We are continually looking to make it more convenient for our families so this is our newest plan...We would like parents that have signed up to participate to please make payments for all of your children by October 1<sup>st</sup>. Please do not wait until your child's birthday. You may pay online through FACTS or send in a physical payment to the School Office. Please make sure to mark Birthday Book Club and your child's name on your envelope containing payments.

With our early school closure last March, we had 36 students that were not able to choose their Birthday Book Club books. Mrs. Pagliara wants these students to know they have not been forgotten! She will begin the Birthday Book Club selections with these students first.

Once these have been completed, we will begin with our current school year Birthday Book Club participants. We are no longer going to wait for the month of your child's birthday. Our new plan is that we will select children to come to the library and pick out their Birthday Book Club books according to their birthday months and classrooms. We will start with July/August birthdays and then keep going on a scheduled basis instead of waiting until your child's birthday month.
