## 2021-2022 ONLINE ENROLLMENT - DUE MAY 1st

We want to remind all our families that 2021-2022 Online Enrollment for your children is due May 1<sup>st</sup>. This includes incoming Kindergarten and Preschool children. For incoming Kindergarten students, this is also the date that a copy of their certified birth certificate and baptism certificate is due. Our incoming Kindergarten classes are just a few students away from being at capacity. We are at the point where a waiting list will be created so please make sure all of your child's enrollment and incoming registration paperwork is complete and submitted by the May 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.

For Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade, the fees that will be due by May 1<sup>st</sup> are the Online Enrollment (\$10.00), Technology (\$50.00), and Instructional Fee (\$190.00) for a total of \$250.00. We ask that you please make every effort to complete enrollment and have all fees paid by this date. As of May 2<sup>nd</sup>, Technology Fees will raise to \$100.00 and Instructional fees will raise to \$290.00. With the enrollment fee, the total per child will now be \$400.00.

We truly want to have every family return to St. Peter School! Please know that several of our classes are close to capacity. After May 1<sup>st</sup> we will offer registration to families on our waiting lists. With this in mind, we want to stress how very important it is that your children's registration is complete. ### COVID GUIDELINES REMINDER - UPDATE AS OF 3/11/2021

We have received guidance that we do not have to send students home that are experiencing the following symptoms: nausea, abdominal pain, nasal congestion, and runny noses. We certainly have seen some of these symptoms in children with COVID, but the IDPH removed them because they typically aren't the only symptom the child has if they have COVID. Students will continue to be sent home if they experience a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees F, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, fatigue, muscle and body aches, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, vomiting or diarrhea. Medical evaluations and testing are still strongly recommended for all persons with these COVID-like symptoms. If one of your children have the symptoms that require them to remain home from school, all school age siblings must also remain home.
