IDPH PHYSICAL AND VISION FORMS - Due to school October 15th

IDPH Physical forms for students in **Grades Kindergarten and Sixth Grade** are due to the School Office **this Friday, October 15th**. This is also a requirement for students entering **Preschool for the first time**. **If we do not have your child's completed form or the date of a scheduled appointment by October 15th, we are mandated by the State of Illinois to exclude your child from attending school until the information has been received.** The exam may have been performed within the past school year, from Aug 18, 2020 until October 29, 2021.

Vision exam forms are also needed for our current **Kindergarten** students. These are also due by **October 15th**. If you need a Physical Exam/Immunization form or a Vision Exam, we have these forms in the School Office. Most of the doctors' offices also have the IDPH physical form. Thank you for your help with this.

4th GRADE PE CLASSES - KROC CENTER'S FIT KIDS

Our 4th grade students will have the opportunity to learn even more about fitness and nutrition as they participate in the Kroc Center's Fit Kids through their PE classes.
