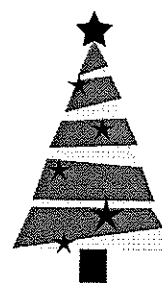


- * WHO: Girls in Pre-School - 8th Grade (Age 3 and up)
