To the parents of future **three-year-old and four-year** old preschool students:

We are excited that it is time to begin registering students for our preschool classes for the **2024-2025 school** year. - A. To hold your spot in the virtual line, your paperwork and registration fee need to be postmarked by Thursday, February 15<sup>th</sup> or dropped off to our school office no later than Thursday, February 15<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 pm.
- B. You will receive an email that will include a Sign-Up Genius link by 4:00 pm on Wednesday, February 21<sup>st</sup>. If you do NOT receive this email, please call the school office between 7:30 am 3:30 pm on Thursday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>.
- C. The sign up will not be activated UNTIL Tuesday, February 27<sup>th</sup>. We want to make sure everyone has the link before it goes LIVE on February 27<sup>th</sup>.
- D. On Tuesday, Feb. 27<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm, the sign-up link will go LIVE! This is taking the place of an in-person line to claim your child's spot for preschool.
- E. Families may sign up for only their own children.

We will do our best to accommodate all the families. It is heartbreaking for us to have to turn away from any students. Unfortunately, we need to limit class sizes to provide a quality education. For more information about our school, please use the contacts below.



#### Mardi Gras 2024 Parent Information

Dear Parents,

Lent will be here soon. To prepare for the season, we are celebrating Mardi Gras Carnival. Our Mardi Gras celebration will be on Tuesday, February 13<sup>th</sup>. The reason for this is two-fold. To show the children the transition from "Fat" Tuesday to Ash Wednesday and our time of penance during Lent.

We will have a Mardi Gras Carnival in the gym that will include games made by the 7-8 grade students. To make this a big success for our students, we ask that each school family make the following donations according to your last name.

A-E: 6 cans of soda per family

F-K: 1 dozen pre-packaged items per family. It is extremely important this year not to send in any products that contain nuts. We have several students who are severely allergic to peanut products. Please read labels carefully. We will not accept any product that contains nuts. Thank You! (Ex: individual bags of chips, Fruit Roll-Ups, Rice Krispie Treats, etc.).
