Do you have an interest or ability that you would like to share with our 7th and 8th graders?

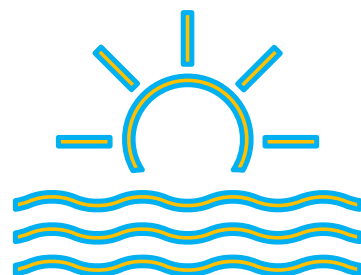
