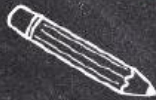

Annually, the four pastors, with their finance councils, assess the financial needs of our schools. After a thorough review, tuition for the 2025-2026 school year will increase by 8.5%. It's important to note that this increase does not cover additional operating expenses like utilities, service contracts, and supplies. These costs will be generously subsidized by our parishes through the support of parishioners.

We recognize that a tuition increase may be challenging for some families. To support those in need, we encourage you to explore the tuition assistance opportunities outlined in the attached document.

We remain committed to creating a supportive and encouraging environment for every student as we grow our schools and nurture future leaders in the Church and beyond. We invite you to share your family's experiences with others in our community and encourage you to reach out to your parish priest or school principal with any questions or concerns. They are here to partner with you in providing the gift of Catholic education.

Thank you for choosing a Catholic education for your child(ren) and entrusting us with their spiritual and academic development. Our schools are a vital ministry of the Church, made possible by the generosity of parishioners. As we look to the 2025-2026 school year, we are excited to continue to build on the **Family School Agreement** that has already made a significant impact. The Family School Agreement includes two key components. First, service hour requirements emphasize active parish and school participation. Second, for Catholic families, Mass attendance remains the cornerstone of our faith. The Eucharist unites us as the Body of Christ and strengthens our entire community. As Catholics, you should attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Day. We realize that travel, sickness, and scheduling may lead you to attend Mass at various parishes; however, you must attend Mass at a participating parish at least 51% of the time. Eighth grade families should still participate in the program as many scholarships to QND take into account Mass attendance.

For Catholic families not currently registered at a parish, we warmly invite you to join one of our four parishes. If you are non-Catholic and interested in learning more about the faith, please reach out to your parish priest.

The Family School Agreement is designed to strengthen our schools, parishes, and families, bringing us closer to Christ and one another. Thank you for your prayers, participation, and support in helping us carry out this mission. May God bless your family and our community in the year ahead.

In order to guarantee a space for your child(ren) - based on enrollment capacity - at any one of the four Catholic elementary schools, the **non-refundable** Resource Fee must be paid by May 7, 2025. Please note current QCES families who still owe tuition and/or fees for the current school year must pay their past due amount by Friday, May 21, 2025, in order to enroll their child(ren).



2025-2026 Tuition Assistance Opportunities Kindergarten - 8th Grade

Quincy Catholic Elementary Schools Foundation

The QCES Foundation provides about \$130,000 in tuition assistance to families each school year. Awards for assistance are based on financial need. Applications, including required supporting documents such as W-2s and tax returns, must be submitted online through the FACTS Grant & Aid Program. While funding is not guaranteed, families who fall within 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines are encouraged to apply.



The QCES Foundation also facilitates multiple scholarships. To be considered for a scholarship, families must complete the scholarship form AND the FACTS Grant & Aid application.

- Fr. Augustus Tolton Scholarship - Full-tuition scholarship (K-8) awarded to one Catholic family at each of the four Quincy Catholic Elementary Schools.
- Newcomer's Scholarship - Partially need based, full-tuition scholarship (K-8), Catholic or non-Catholic, whose family does not currently have any children enrolled at QCS.
- St. Thomas Aquinas Scholarship - Full-tuition and fees scholarship (K-8) awarded to two families who do not currently have any children enrolled at QCS. The scholarship is intended for students of color, non-Catholic students, students below poverty level, or students with disabilities.

Gene Grawe Fund

Participation in the Gene Grawe Fund can offset tuition by the purchase of gift cards offered through many retailers. These businesses donate a percentage of the profits which is then distributed to the tuition accounts of the families participating. Every year, during Spring school registration, all students and their parents are extended the opportunity to participate in the Gene Grawe Fund. 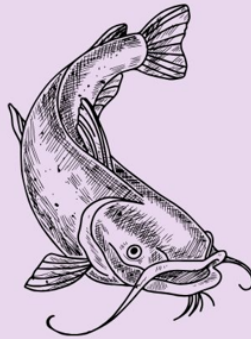

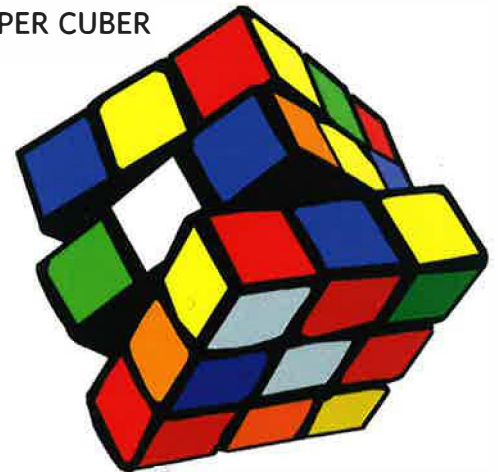

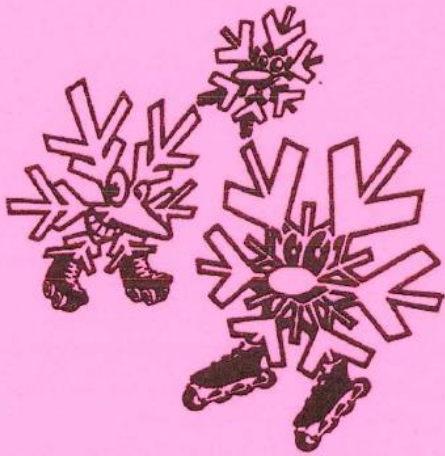
