SCHOOL BUSINESS:

- Olympic Day: Thursday, April 24th for grades 5th- 8th at QND. Buses will leave St. Peter School at 8:30am. Students <u>MUST</u> wear their <u>OLYMPIC DAY SHIRT</u> with out of dress code bottoms. OLYMPIC DAY 2025

March 7, 2025

Dear Parents of Grades 5-8:

On Thursday, April 24th (rain date is Monday, May 5th) grades 5th-8th will be attending Olympic Day 2025 from 9:00am - 2:00pm at QND. We will be leaving St. Peter School around 8:30 a.m. The Olympic Day will be attended by 5th-8th grades from all Quincy Parochial Schools, St. Mary School in Mt. Sterling, and Holy Family in Hannibal. This event is an extension of our physical education programs and gives them the experience of a real track meet situation. Olympic Day has been coordinated by a group of teacher representatives from each of the schools.

<u>Dress for the day:</u> Students <u>MUST</u> wear the official lime green Olympic Day T-shirt. The shirt must be in the original state (no extra writing or altered in any way). Shorts or sweats are allowed. Shorts must be modest in length. <u>Biker shorts are not allowed</u> unless they are worn under another pair of appropriate shorts. Clothing should not have offensive writing or be contrary to health or Catholic principals. Athletic shoes and socks should be worn. <u>NO</u> cleats or spikes! There is no need for bandanas or other distracting accessories including hair coloring or capes, etc. With this dress code in place students will be dressed appropriately for the day. <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Anyone dressed inappropriately will need to call their parents before leaving for QND for the appropriate attire and the parents will need to transport them to QND if we have already left. If any dress or appearance is altered after they arrive at QND, parents will be called to pick up their child.

Students may want to bring sunscreen and wear a hat. If the day appears to be cool, a jacket and a blanket or large towel to sit on is suggested. Students should bring their own lunch and drinks. NO SODA. NO GLASS containers. Students are responsible for throwing away their trash and cleaning up after themselves. If a student has an inhaler for asthma, he/she should bring it along on this day. <u>ABSOLUETLY NO GUM IS ALLOWED!</u>

STUDENTS SHOULD NOT BRING ANY ELECTRONIC DEVICES. Cell phones, headsets, Ipods, etc. are to be left at home.

Please sign the permission slip (parent side and student side) and return to school by **Monday, March 31st.**

Parents are invited to stop by at any time during the day to enjoy the events and to cheer for our students and our school! We look forward to an exciting day!

Rules and Guidelines: The 7th/8th Grade Spring Dance is open to all QCES seventh and eighth grade students. (No outside guests are permitted.) Doors will open at 6:45 p.m. Music will start at 7:00 p.m. All students must arrive by 7:15 p.m. and be picked up no later than 9:00 p.m. Parents must come inside the QND gym to pick up their child. We remain committed to creating a supportive and encouraging environment for every student as we grow our schools and nurture future leaders in the Church and beyond. They are here to partner with you in providing the gift of Catholic education.

In order to guarantee a space for your child(ren) - based on enrollment capacity - at any one of the four Catholic elementary schools, the **non-refundable** Resource Fee must be paid by May 7, 2025. Please note current QCES families who still owe tuition and/or fees for the current school year must pay their past due amount by Friday, May 21, 2025, in order to enroll their child(ren).



2025-2026 Tuition Assistance Opportunities Kindergarten - 8th Grade

Quincy Catholic Elementary Schools Foundation

The QCES Foundation provides about \$130,000 in tuition assistance to families each school year. Awards for assistance are based on financial need. Applications, including required supporting documents such as W-2s and tax returns, must be submitted online through the FACTS Grant & Aid Program. While funding is not guaranteed, families who fall within 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines are encouraged to apply.



The QCES Foundation also facilitates multiple scholarships. To be considered for a scholarship, families must complete the scholarship form AND the FACTS Grant & Aid application.

- Fr. Augustus Tolton Scholarship Full-tuition scholarship (K-8) awarded to one Catholic family at each of the four Quincy Catholic Elementary Schools.
- Newcomer's Scholarship Partially need based, full-tuition scholarship (K-8), Catholic or non-Catholic, whose family does not currently have any children enrolled at QCS.
- St. Thomas Aquinas Scholarship Full-tuition and fees scholarship (K-8) awarded to two families who do not currently have any children enrolled at QCS. The scholarship is intended for students of color, non-Catholic students, students below poverty level, or students with disabilities.


